Re: Connection to New Sewer Line

Dear Property Owner:

The Town of Eagar has received approval from Arizona Department Environmental Quality (ADEQ) to operate the new sewer line installed in Brown and Hamblin St's.

The Town of Eagar Council on November 13, 2012 approved Resolution 2012-29, which states that once approval is given from ADEQ all homes must be connected to the new sewer line within 180 days from the approval from ADEQ. At the end of the 180 days the old sewer line will be abandoned. I have attached a copy of Resolution 2012-29 for your review.

The start date for the 180 days is January 4, 2013. All properties must be connected to the new sewer line not later than July 5, 2013

If you have contacted with the Town to have Greg Erhart do the connection, he will be contacting you shortly. You will be required to contact the Water Department to arrange for payments on your water bill.


All others will need to complete the work yourself or hire your own contractor to complete the connection within the 180 days.

All connections will require a permit and have inspections. No fees will be charged for the permit.

Within 90 days after the abandonment the Town of Eagar will crush and fill in the old manholes. If you happen to have an old manhole in your back yard we will need access through you back yard to the old manholes at that time.
